Tutorial

This tutorial has been made to help you take your first baby-steps into the world of OpenSource publishing softwares.

Starting The Software

In your Firefox menubar, click on *Tools*.
Then click on *guTen Tag* to launch the
application.

A New Project

Goto the *File* menu and click *New*.

Going about it...

Fill in the

Project Name

The name of the project directory

The directory you want the project to
be stored in

*(Now, let us make a video based
project)*

Select a video from your harddisk.

Loaded???

Let's try and tweak around a bit...

Try playing the video...

Try adding a tag here!

Oops!!!

We haven't added anything to library.

First go and add , say a pdf document, to the library.

Importing Media

Click on the *import* button in the toolbar.

In the dialog box, select a pdf or image or unicode documet to import.

Here, let us use *a.pdf*.

Displaying a document

Clicking on the pdf in the library displays in
the *content viewer*.

Tagging

Now,

Goto the *tag editor* and select *a.pdf* from the dropdown menu.

Now enter a page number to display it in the *content viewer*.

Also type in a *Title* for the tag.

Click on *Add* to add the tag.

The added tag appers in the *Tags* list.

More Tags...

Click on the Scroll Bar and drag it to seek in the video.

Now try adding some more images/documents to the library and make a few more tags.

External Links...

You can also add external links as tags.

Click on *add link* button and type in the link location.

Seek/play to the place you want to add this link at.

Now from the *URL* drop down menu select the added link and add tag.

You also have the option of removing the *title*.

Changes...

To change an existing tag

Select that tag from the *Tags* drop down menu.

Now make any changes you want to.

Finally click *Change* to bring the changes into effect.

Saving The Project...

Click on the *Save* menu to save the current state of the project into the system

Tip! *Always Save your project to be sure that your critical changes are safe in case of any system problems.*

Next Steps...

After you're done with creating your project you might want to:

Preview your project in it's current state:

Goto the *File* menu or click
Preview
on the toolbar.

Publish a finished project

On clicking the *Publish* button on the toolbar, a dialog box appears. Select the directory you want to export the project to.

Published Project

The project is published to the chosen directory by the name

*publish_****projectName***

The published directory can now be hosted on the net...

More Projects

The editor is pretty flexible and can be used in a variety of ways.

For Example, An audio file can be included instead of an flv as the main media file.

Adios...

You might encounter a save prompt if you've made any changes since you last saved the project.
