## To Avoid Problems Read This First

- 1. It is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to contact your instructor as soon as a tentative assignment is made. You <u>MUST</u> ask your instructor about Semester Prep duties and if you are expected to attend class lectures and / or hold discussion sections. If you are expected to attend lectures and / or hold discussion sections <u>YOU MUST</u> check the timetable to ensure your are free during those times.
- 2. You are <u>REQUIRED</u> to stay until final grades are <u>ENTERED</u>. You are being PAID for this time (actually beyond this time). Exceptions are permitted <u>ONLY</u> at the discretion of your instructor. It is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to make arrangements with your faculty member <u>AS SOON AS POSSIBLE</u>.
- To increase the likelihood of you being assigned to a course that you request, it is <u>YOUR</u> responsibility to find out what courses are being offered. Consult University Timetables and

## Non-Native English Speakers

- 1. <u>All</u> International Students and students for whom English is a second language must take the SPEAK Test. Those who have taken the test previously and scored LESS THAN 50 must take the test again each semester.
- If you score 45 or less on the SPEAK Test you are required to enroll in an English as a Second Language course such as English 122. You <u>MUST</u> produce proof of enrollment <u>AND</u> completion of ESL course(s).
- 3. Satisfactory spoken English is a specific part of your offer of aid: "For students who are non-native speakers of English and who are appointed as teaching assistants, guarantees are also contingent on meeting departmental standards for spoken English proficiency. Failure to meet the required level of proficiency may lead to cancellation of an appointment and cancellation of the support guarantee."
