To Avoid Problems Read This First

1. It is YOUR responsibility to contact your instructor as soon as a tentative assignment is made. You MUST ask your instructor about Semester Prep duties and if you are expected to attend class lectures and / or hold discussion sections. If you are expected to attend lectures and / or hold discussion sections YOU MUST check the timetable to ensure you are free during those times.
2. You are REQUIRED to stay until final grades are ENTERED. You are being PAID for this time (actually beyond this time). Exceptions are permitted ONLY at the discretion of your instructor. It is YOUR responsibility to make arrangements with your faculty member AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
3. To increase the likelihood of you being assigned to a course that you request, it is YOUR responsibility to find out what courses are being offered. Consult University Timetables and

If you request to TA a course that is not being offered, you will definitely not get it.

4. Fill out your past course history COMPLETELY including grades and a list of your current classes for which grades are not yet available. I have close to 100 applications to review, I cannot look up your transcripts.
5. There is an ALL TA Meeting on the FRIDAY BEFORE CLASSES START at 10 AM in room 1240 (or 1221). ALL TAs are REQUIRED TO ATTEND – NO EXCEPTIONS. PLAN ACCORDINGLY. THOSE ABSENT WILL HAVE SALARY DOCKED AND MAY LOSE THEIR POSITION.

Non-Native English Speakers

1. All International Students and students for whom English is a second language must take the SPEAK Test. Those who have taken the test previously and scored LESS THAN 50 must take the test again each semester.
2. If you score 45 or less on the SPEAK Test you are required to enroll in an English as a Second Language course such as English 122. You MUST produce proof of enrollment AND completion of ESL course(s).
3. Satisfactory spoken English is a specific part of your offer of aid:
“For students who are non-native speakers of English and who are appointed as teaching assistants, guarantees are also contingent on meeting departmental standards for spoken English proficiency. Failure to meet the required level of proficiency may lead to cancellation of an appointment and cancellation of the support guarantee.”
