

HW1: AI101 Reflection

Assignment Goals:

- Familiarize yourself with the Big Picture in the Artificial Intelligence world
- Reflect on AI and its role in your own life

Your Task:

This assignment must be completed individually and must be your original work.

Read the [Stanford One Hundred Year Study on Artificial Intelligence 2021 Report](#) in its entirety. It's 82 pages long, so plan accordingly.

Then **write** a short essay (500-600 words, in English) to **challenge one point in the report**, and **cite at least 3 references**. Note that references will **not** be counted in your final word count. There should be no identifying information (like name, student ID, etc.) in the essays. The reference format is up to you (look at how typical papers do it).

Deliverables:

The essay in a plain .txt file called essay.txt and the references in a plain .txt file called references.txt. Please make sure the file names are correct. Put the two .txt files in a zip file named hw1_<netid>.zip, where you replace <netid> with your netID (your wisc.edu login). Then submit the zip file.

Please directly pack the .txt files into a zip file. Do not put them into some folder and then pack the folder. When creating a zip on MAC, it can contain a "_MACOSX" folder, which is fine.
